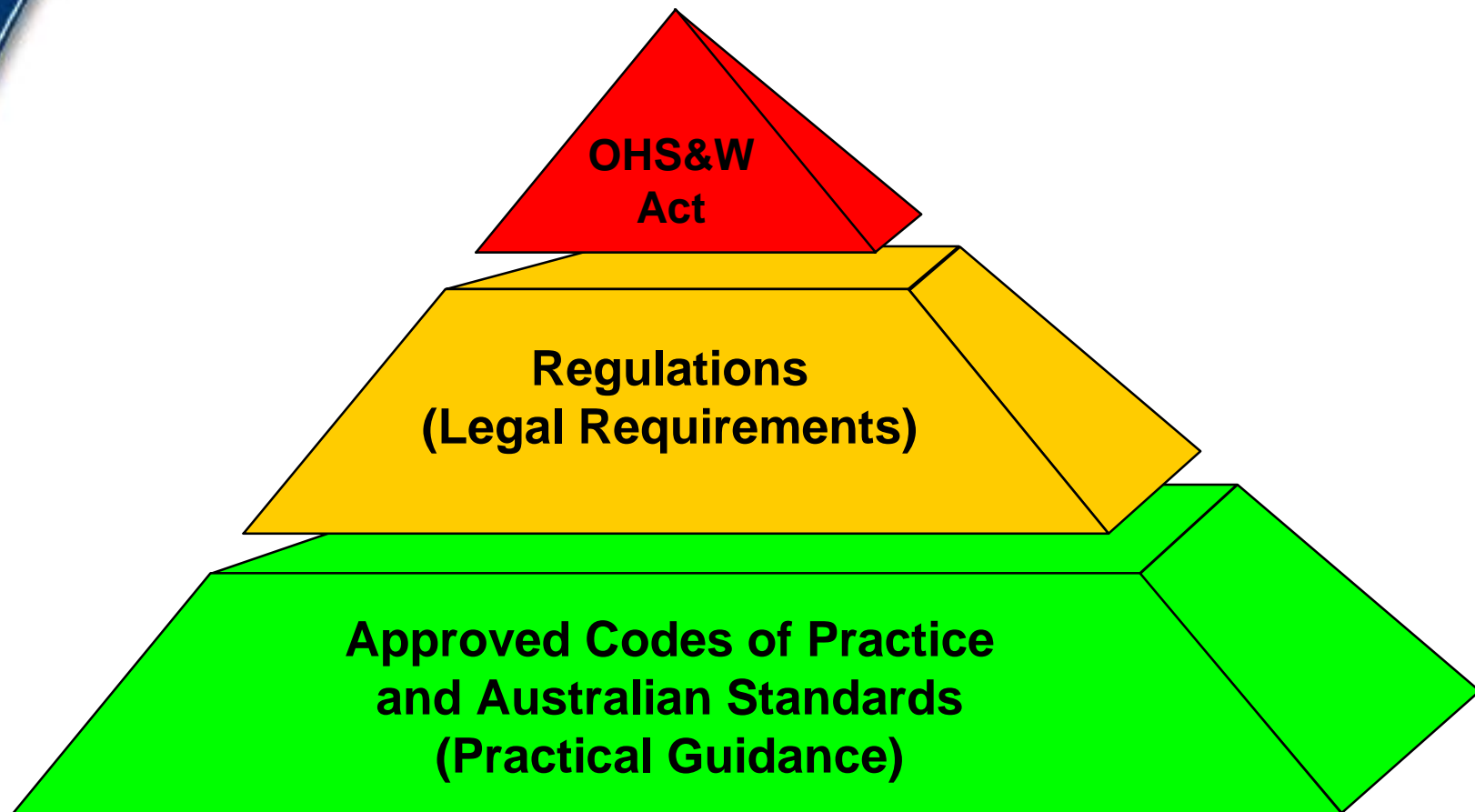

Information, training and supervision for workers

A process to involve workers in health and safety issues

A process to identify, assess and fix dangers

Records of workplace injuries and illnesses

Workers must...

Not put themselves or others at risk of being injured or made ill

Use equipment provided by their employer to protect their health, safety and welfare

Follow reasonable instructions given to protect their health, safety and welfare

Ensure they do not put themselves or others at risk by taking drugs or alcohol
